

COFFEE FILTER TURKEY



Supplies -

- coffee filters
- washable markers
- spay bottle (with water)
- brown paint
- paint brushes
- popsicle stick/clothespin
- scissors
- construction paper
- glue

Instructions:

- 1.Start by flattening out ground coffee filters. 2.Draw on them with several colors of
- 2.Draw on them with several colors of washable markers in a variety of patterns alternating from red, orange, yellow, and brown.
- 3.Lay the colored coffee filter on a baking sheet or surface that is easily cleaned and spray it with water. Set aside to dry.
- 4. Paint all sides of the clothespin or popsicle stick with brown paint. Set aside to dry.
- 5. Fold coffee filters in half and attach the clothespin/popsicle stick
- 6. Finally, glue on googly eyes or you can draw them on then add a beak and gobbler to complete your turkey!



SALT ART SNOWFLAKES



Supplies -

- white school glue
- paint brush
- card stock
- pencil
- salt
- watercolor or water with food coloring can act as a substitute

Instructions:

- 1. Use the bottle of glue to draw a snowflake
- 2. Put a good amount of salt onto the glue and then carefully pour the excess salt off.
- 3. Let the glue and salt painting dry.
- 4. Mix a few tablespoons of water with liquid watercolors or food dye.
- 5. Then, use a paintbrush to drip the coloring onto the salt-painted snowflakes slowly.
- 6. You can add other colors and mix the colors on each snowflake for a stunning effect.
- 7. Let your snowflakes dry overnight



STRAW WREATH PAINTING



Supplies -

- embellishments
- paper plate
- card stock
- scissors
- straw
- paint
- glue

Instructions:

- 1. Start by sketching a basic framework for your wreath.
- 2. Proceed to cut five slits, each about 1-1/2 inches long and spaced 2 centimeters apart, using your straw.
- 3. Utilize your fingers to flatten and widen the slits.
- 4. Afterward, dip the straw into your paint and imprint it onto the paper, forming a circular shape along the traced outline.
- 5. Continue stamping the paint onto the paper until the wreath takes shape.
- 6. Finally, adorn the wreath with embellishments of your choosing!
